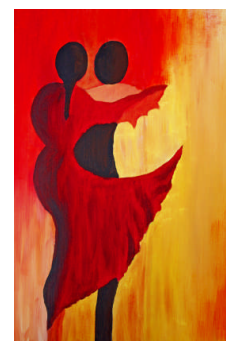




## Soul Dance: Creating Conscious Relationships

**Connection:** Developing spiritual, emotional, mental and sexual contact through recognizing soul connection and understanding masculine and feminine essence.

**Commitment:** To forming a partnership supporting what you are creating together in your relationship, family, and purpose in the world.
